



Events like these are a great opportunity to showcase Victoria's fantastic regional areas and sports facilities located along the Murray River.



I welcome all visitors to this year's event and I invite you to experience the many good things that this beautiful region has to offer.







Events Description







Wake Slaion Once again the skier is allowed two fifteen second passes through the course. In this time the skier attempts as many crosses of the wake as he or she can complete. There are different levels of scoring and more points are given for crossing the wake on one foot rather than two and more points again for crossing backwards on one foot rather than forwards.



Jump This is probably the most spectacular event from a spectator point of view as it is accomplished right in front of the crowd. The competitor may choose a speed no greater than Seventy – two kilometers per hour for their pass over the jump in the barefoot position and then land and ski away from the jump to register a score. They are given three attempts to do this and the aim is to achieve the longest distance from the jump to the landing.
