CCI EURE-ET-LOIR

The French Waterski and Wakeboard Federation is pleased to announce that it has been awarded the honour of hosting the 2025 IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships.

The event will take place on the **private lake of Saint Prest**, also known as "**Étang du Gorget**," situated near the city of **Chartres**. This lake has previously hosted numerous French National Barefoot Championships, as well as the 2011 and 2022 European Barefoot Championships.

Spanning **1080 meters in length**, the lake offers excellent wind protection, thanks to the surrounding trees that provide a natural barrier on nearly all sides.

EVENTS AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There will be **three events**: slalom, tricks, and jump. Each event will consist of **two rounds**, with the exception of the **jump event for Divisions II-IV**, which will feature only a **final round**. **No jump event** will be held for **Division V**.

The competition is open to both **men and women** in the following divisions. Skiers must compete in their respective divisions. Age eligibility is determined by the skier's age on **December 31st** of the year preceding the Masters Championships.

Please note that **jump scores** for **Divisions II-IV** will not be included in the **individual or team overall standings**.

BOATS

The main tow boat for the events will be the **Ski Brendella Barefooter**, equipped with a **250HP Suzuki outboard engine**, **tower** and **super fly high**.

Two **Flightcraft** back-up boats will also be available onsite. Further details will be provided in Bulletin 2.





SKIERS ENTRY FEES

Entry fees for the competition are as follows:

Three events: €400
Two events: €350
One event: €300

TRAINING

Training will be available on the competition lake in the days leading up to the championships, with the event's boat. The cost is €240 per hour, including the driver.





DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the **IWWF Anti-Doping Rules**, doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. IWWF SAFE SPORT POLICY & IWWF SAFEGUARDING REGULATIONS

We take safeguarding extremely seriously and are committed to ensuring that everyone who attends the championships, whether athletes, officials or volunteers can operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. It is a condition of participation that all attendees familiarise themselves and comply with the **IWWF Safeguarding Regulations** which are available <u>HERE</u>

IWWF LICENSE

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF License fee from 2021 where athletes wishing to compete in Ranking List / 1 to 6 Star competitions (including IWWF World titled events) in each Sports Division of the IWWF are **required** to hold an **IWWF License**. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their athletes hold a valid <u>IWWF License</u> in order to participate in the 2025 IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships



INTENT TO ENTER

Federations wishing to register skiers for the 2025 IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships must notify the World Barefoot Council and the LOC of their intention to compete, along with an **estimated number of entries**. This should be submitted using the **Intent to Enter Form**, found in **Appendix A** of this bulletin, no later than **May 18, 2025**.

The deadline for each Federation to declare, **through EMS**, the names of the members of its team, the events each will enter, as well as the names of the official reserves is **four weeks before** the scheduled start of the first event of the IWWF World Championships. An entry is considered complete when the Skier's name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays the WBC a fine of \$20 (USD) per skier per day after the four-week deadline, for each skier not officially entered.

May 18, 2025	Deadline for submitting the Intention to Enter Form
August 10, 2025	Deadline to enter participants (Team members / Individuals) in the EMS

All fines must be **paid on-site** to the IWWF Representative at the Championships. No skiers will be allowed to start if any due fine is not paid.

In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition, their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of 2 days the day before the start of the competition.

A valid excuse may include a **sickness certificate** or a **certificated injury** and should be considered and agreed as valid by the IWWF Representative at the Championships.

Payment of the Entry Fee for the event must be made as per the deadline in the above table. Payment will be made via bank transfer, with details to be provided in Info Bulletin 2.

REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS IN EMS

The registration of the skier participation and jury members in EMS must be done by an **EMS Federation Administrator** as follows:


- (1) EMS Federation Administrator has to login to EMS
- ② Go to Competitions menu and enter Competition Code 25IWWF05 in the search filters.
- (3) Select the competition listed "2025 IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships".
- (4) Select Participations tab and click "New participation" button to register the Athletes.
- (5) Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right.
- (6) Register the Category in Competition, the Events, and the Entry Type.
- (7) Click on the blue "Add" button and the participant will be registered.

Repeat Steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants.



ATHLETE INFORMATION FOR COMMENTATOR & MEDIA

Kindly ask your athletes to log into the IWWF's EMS to update or complete their profiles. This includes details such as accomplishments, sponsors, social media handles, and any other relevant information in the optional fields. This will help ensure that the **event commentator** has easy access to key details to share with both the live audience and viewers online. Additionally, athletes should upload their photos for media coverage.



IMPORTANT: To be able to complete/populate their profiles, the Athletes must be **EMS** USERS, i.e. they must be invited by their respective Federations to become EMS users and have accepted this invitation. Athletes should contact their respective Federations if they are not active / confirmed EMS users.

TRANSPORT



Chartres is about 88 km from Paris (1 hour drive). Key routes include:

- A6 highway (Paris to Bordeaux), A10, A11
- Local roads: RN10, D923, RN154



■ There are around 33 daily trains from Paris-Montparnasse (approx. 1 hour).

- Connections are available to other cities like Le Mans and regions in Brittany.

Paris airports are easily accessible:

- Orly: 75 km (45 minutes by car)
- Charles de Gaulle: 120 km (80 minutes)
- Complimentary transport will be provided for all Technical Officials between the airport and the official hotel. Athletes and coaches are responsible for arranging their own transportation.

CEREMONIES AND BANQUET

VISA INFORMATION

Schengen Visa: France is part of the Schengen Area, so a Schengen visa allows travel within most European countries for up to 90 days. This is for short stays (tourism, business, etc.).

Long-Stay Visa: If someone plans to stay longer than 90 days in France, they need a long-stay visa, which is required for work, study, or extended stays.

Who Needs a Visa?

- **EU/EER Citizens**: No visa required, just a valid ID or passport.
- **Non-EU Citizens**: Most people from outside the EU/EER need a visa to enter France unless their country has a visa waiver agreement for short stays.

Application Process: Applications must be submitted to the French consulate or embassy in the home country. Required documents typically include:

- Completed visa application form
- Valid passport (at least 3 months beyond the planned departure date)
- Proof of purpose (e.g., event invitation)
- Financial proof
- Travel insurance

CHARTRES

Chartres, located **80km southwest of Paris**, is best known for its stunning **Notre-Dame cathedral**, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture. Built between 1194 and 1260, it's renowned for its impressive stained-glass windows and intricate stonework. The cathedral's geometry, Renaissance choir screen, and original 12th-and 13th-century windows make it a must-see. Visitors can also admire the **13th-century labyrinth** on the nave floor, a fascinating detail which is also subtly incorporated into the **competition logo**.






Aside from the cathedral, explore the Musée des Beaux Arts, featuring tapestries and works by Vlaminck and Zurbaran. The medieval town, with charming old houses and the Romanesque St-André church, offers further sightseeing opportunities.

EXTRAS

- A **food truck** will be available on-site throughout the week during **lunchtime**, offering a variety of meals. **Beverages** will also be sold on-site. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided at no cost to the Technical Officials by the organizing committee.
- Each team must bring **2 flags** of their country (approximately 100x150 cm or 100x200 cm). The flags will be returned on or before the conclusion of the Final Banquet.
- All teams should send an MP3 of their national anthem or confirm the anthem is on Spotify.
- Official merchandise will be available for purchase. You can either order online before the competition or buy items directly at the venue.
- Payments at the lake can be made in **cash or by card** using SumUp. Please note that the currency used in France is the **Euro**. There will also be an option to withdraw cash at nearby ATMs, but please be aware of any **potential additional fees**.
- **Two evening activities** will be organized to give everyone the opportunity to explore the city and make the experience unforgettable.
- **Fun fact**: All action photos included in this bulletin were taken by the official photographer for the Masters.
