


BRITISH BAREFOOT HISTORY






David Small - multiple World, Region EA and national champion



In 1971, the British Barefoot Club was officially formed by the British Water Ski Federation. Before that, barefooting in the UK was a rare and elitist art, mostly seen as demonstrations during classic water ski tournaments.

Prominent amongst the pioneers was Charles Ramsey, a KLM airline pilot, who won the fitst ever competition held in Europe, on August 11th, 1968:

Charles Ramsey, a 52 year old Englishman who is a K.L.M. pilot living in Rotterdam, won the first Barefoot Ski Competition (staged by the Cirencester Water Ski Club on 11th August) and took back to Holland a beautiful cut glass whisky decanter—the WATERSPORT Chalenge Trophy. Charles is a short, tough character who did not start water skiing until he was 39 years old. He looked fitter than a good many at South Cerney who were half his age and is a credit to the sport. And what a demonstration of "barefoot" technique he gave. First came ski starts, then deep water starts, and finally the running start from the shore. When this last trick was successfully completed a spontaneous cheer broke out from the crowd and the boat driver thought something was amiss, so he slowed down—with dire results to poor Charles.

Second man away was 17 year old Danny Robin, who has just left college and will shortly take up an appointment as an engineer. He and the third man, Philip Erhardt, also gave sparkling performances and at the end of the event it was announced that only 1½ points separated these three competitors. Nine barefoot skiers took part. A smaller field of six competitors entered the Kite Competition which was being organised for the second year. Last year it was necessary only to rise and land in a straight line but progress in this sport has been so rapid that this year a special slalom course was used and the "kiters" had to sail round the buoys. The slalom event was followed by a display of tricks. Without doubt the kite flyer of the day was Tony Richardson, Secretary of the British Water Ski Federation. It was he who taught another Tony (Lord Snowdon) how to "fly his kite". What a show he put on as, with superb control, he swooped across the course, being credited with two buoys in the slalom and taking second place in tricks.

For his tricks the "pilot" has to perform various semiacrobatic and balancing feats in mid-air. While performing one of these Andrew Jackson from Yorkshire had a horrifying crash, luckily without damage to himself, although his kite was bent. This meant that his trick score was low but his success in slalom was sufficient to give him third place overall. Second place overall went to Toby Blackwell of Oxford who gained the top score in tricks largely due to his achieving the difficult "free layout" which involves hanging horizontally below the kite, supported only by the harness, with arms outstretched, and this some 50 ft. up in the air!

After the contest Andrew Jackson raised an interesting point. He does his kiting on the River Ouse and spends more time over the land than he does the water. Does he need a pilot's licence, he asks?

Then John Doherty of the 3T's club at Standlake encouraged a whole group of likely lads and lasses to take up the call. An early and able administrator was Graham Stevens of Gloucestershire, who was largely responsible for corralling the wild elements of pre 1971 into the structured British barefoot scene of 1974, with the first major step forward, with the first national championships

Bomere Pool near Shrewsbury, the home of Shropshire Water Ski Cub, is well known for its smooth water being sheltered by high ground and trees, yet on the two days chosen by the organisers a howing gale funnelled down the length of water causing white horses! — A phenomenon not seen before in these parts. Despite the weather no events were cancelled and large crowds of spectators were entertained to two days of high speed skiing. Due to the number of International Barefooters present it was agreed to run an International Invitation Championships simultaneously, with entries from Australia, Spain and Holland.

On Saturday all events were run through to find the Overall Champions and the resu ts were :—

1st—Dennis Akins, Trent Power Boat and Ski Club, 2,842-11 points; 2nd—Mike Wilkes, Tidal Water Ski Club, 2,162-50 points; 3rd—Anthony Lloyd, Whitney Aquatic, 1,794-08 points; 4th — Don Urquhart, Biggleswade W.S.C., 1.709-87 points; 5th—Jackie Crawford, N. Ireland, 1081-58 points.

In the evening a barbecue and disco dance was held in a large marquee at which vast quantities of food and ale were consumed till the early hours. Oh! yes we also had cur very own streakers, one of whom cut his foot, of all things!

Competitors and officials slept off the effect of the night in the clubhouse; marquee; commentating box and anywhere else they could find, only to be awakened by a But in style Wakey! Wakey! call full blast over the tancy at 7.30 a.m.

On Sunday the individual events were run joining up with the scores for the previous day.

Barefoot Jumping


Due to the rough water no successful landings were recorded in the National events, but jumps of up to 55ft. were measured before fa!ls. The only successful jump was a distance of 30-5ft. by Steve Curtis (Australia).

A ski show was run between events with Stephanie Wood, of Dudley W.S.C., Redge Greenhouse and Kingsley Webb, of Parklands W.S.C., giving a display of conventional ski jumping.

Tony Rigby, from Stoke W.S.C. gave an exceptional display of kiting in the high wind and Steve Gaskin, from Swanley in Kent, demonstrated parachuting, and rose to a great height maintained for several minutes, whilst the boat driver headed very slowly into the wind. Finally Anthony Lloyd gave a demonstration on how to barefoot start by jumping from a 12ft. high tower

At the prize giving our commentator and Club Chairman, John Mansell, asked Edgar Hilery, M.B.E., Chairman of the West Midlands Sports Council, and Mrs. Harcourt, of AMOCO, to present the Cups and Medals. Our Chairman then thanked our sponsors, AMOCO (UK) Ltd., and their distributors, Oakley's of Shrewsbury, who generously made these Championships viable.

Appreciation was shown to the Chief Judge, Sandy Primo, and boat driver, David Drew, with bottles of Whiskey, and the International winners received bottles of Champagne and tankards, concluding a very enjoyable two-day event.

Again in 1974, John Doherty set a barefoot endurance record of over one hour. During the same year, a team was sent to Spain for another international event where Jackie Crawford won gold in jump with a feet to feet (worth 30 % extra length at that time).




In 1976, came the first European Championships, held at Princes Club and with full TV coverage throughout. Team from the continent came in force, but Great Britain won the team event, as well as each individual event with Mike Thomas as the first European champion.

In 1977, the British team came second again at Princes, when the South Africans sent a highly talented team, who won both team event and individual men title, before being banned from international scene for political reasons.

1977 was a very significant year for the barefoot scene, as John and Margaret Hacker toured Europe, coaching many teams and spent almost a whole summer in Great Britain. John introduced the full use of the boom, modern training methods and produced one of the first instruction handbook.

Peter Pearl and Colin Black were named in the Group II Barefoot Council, created the same year.






A team from Great Britain entered the first World Barefoot Championships in 1978, finishing at fourth place.

The first medal at a World Championship was for Chris Harris, bronze medallist in the 1980 slalom event. In 1986 Chris Harris got anew the third place, this time in the jump event.

slalom medallists at 1980 World Championships : 2nd John Stekelenburg (AUS), 1st Brett Wing (AUS), 3rd Ron Scarpa (USA) and Chris Harris (GBR).

During the 1986 World Championships, Michelle Doherty - John's daughter - won the gold medal in the first ever women jump competition at a World Level. The British team won its first bronze medal in team overall.



Other Gold medallists at a World Level are Lucy Scopes (1997 junior tricks) and David Small, who won his first gold in 1999 (junior overall) and many others since then!


